ATCO FRONTEC AWARDED FIRST UNITED NATIONS CONTRACT Providing Support Services to the United Nations Mission in Kosovo

CALGARY, Alberta – ATCO Frontec has been awarded its first-ever contract with the United Nations to provide camp support and food services to the United Nations Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK).

ATCO Frontec is delivering support services at several camps in Kosovo, used by members of international military police units serving with the mission. Work began last month.

"We have demonstrated our abilities in providing service to deployed operations in challenging environments overseas," said Harry Wilmot, President, ATCO Frontec. "ATCO Frontec will continue to pursue new business in this sector and our growing customer base proves our capabilities."
